In Bible times, the father would arrange his daughter's marriage through a custom called betrothal, which was more binding than our modern practice of getting engaged.



According to the Jewish law at that time, Joseph should have divorced Mary when he found out she was going to have a baby. If he didn't divorce her, many people would not think he followed God's laws. Joseph cared for Mary, and he didn't want to humiliate her, so he decided to call off their engagement quietly.

While Joseph was struggling with the situation, an angel (probably Gabriel) appeared to him in a dream. The angel said, "Joseph, son of David, don't be afraid to take Mary as your wife, because the child she carries was conceived by the Holy Spirit. She will give birth to a son, and you will call him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins."

When Joseph woke up, he remembered the angel's words and did just what the angel commanded. He took Mary as his wife and cared for her until the baby was born. Joseph became Jesus' earthly father, and he loved Jesus as his own son.



Connect the dots in the picture. Start at 1 and go to 20. Then you will see what Joseph saw in his dream.





Use the angel cryptogram to solve the puzzle. Then you will see what the angel told Joseph in the dream.




